1447–1455: Pope Nicholas V establishes Vatican Library.

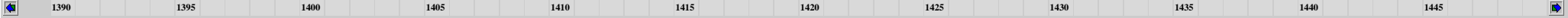
ca. 1445: Johann Gutenberg (ca. 1400–1467), printing with movable type.

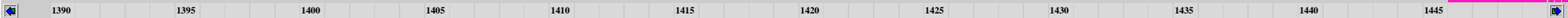
